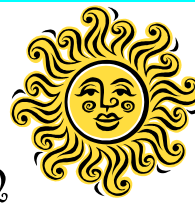

DIRECTIONS TO COLORADO COLLEGE

From I-25 Southbound to Colorado Springs, take exit 143 (Uintah). At the end of the ramp, turn left (Eastbound) onto Uintah. At the second traffic light (intersection with Cascade), turn right onto Cascade (Southbound). This is the Colorado College campus area. The next major road is Cache le Poudre (there is a light). Turn right (Westbound) onto Cache le Poudre and head down the hill. The first building on the right is the Student Center, the second is the Ice Hockey arena and the third building is the Schlessman Natatorium (pool) and Gymnasium (there is a yellow sign near the entrance). Park on the streets in the area.
